East Valley Water District (District) will begin a wastewater (also known as sewer) rehabilitation project on Paloma Road between Golondrina Drive and Del Rosa Avenue on **Tuesday, May 30 and Wednesday, May 31, 2017.**

Residents on Paloma Road are asked to minimize the use of toilets, showers, washing machines, and any other items that drain to the public wastewater between the hours of 8:00am – 4:00pm on May 30 and May 31, 2017. The contractor will be installing a liner in the wastewater pipeline that will temporarily block your drain flows.

Using these facilities during the scheduled work hours will cause a wastewater overflow into your home.

Please see the map on the back of this notice for more information on the homes impacted by these repairs.

Please remember to be cautious in the construction zone. For the safety of motorists and construction crews, please observe all warning signs. Thank you for your patience as we complete this project. These improvements represent a significant investment in maintaining a reliable wastewater system for the community served by the District.

IMPORTANT PROJECT DETAILS

DATES / HOURS

Work will take place between 8:00 am — 4:00 pm on Tuesday, May 30 and Wednesday, May 31, 2017.

PARKING

Street parking of vehicles on Paloma Road will be unavailable during the scheduled work times. Residents are asked to move cars to allow for equipment, operational vehicles, and emergency vehicle traffic.

MEDICAL NEEDS

Customers with medical conditions should call the District at (909) 806-4092 to make arrangements, if necessary.

TRAFFIC

Construction will take place on Paloma Road only. Temporary lane closures will be in place to allow for equipment and operational vehicles in the roadway. Residences and emergency vehicles will have access throughout the project.

WASTEWATER SERVICE

This construction will require a temporary disruption to your wastewater services. There will be no disruption to your water services.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

PALOMA ROAD WASTEWATER PIPELINE REHABILITATION

The District has identified a 700-foot section of wastewater main along Paloma Road that needs to be repaired. Instead of completely replacing the pipe, a liner will be installed to provide strength and seal all cracks. This will allow staff to focus on preventative maintenance and reduce the need for emergency repairs.

The current Sewer Master Plan identified the need for a number of capital improvement projects. Selection of these projects have been based on the evaluation of the positive impact that they will each have on customers, maintaining existing facilities, and continuing to meet local, state, and federal requirements.

Shaded residences on Paloma Road will be impacted by the scheduled project.
Wastewater pipelines will be accessed through manholes along Paloma Road.
