In providing reliable service, the District makes regular maintenance and repairs an important element of our water system improvement efforts. East Valley Water District (District) will begin a water main line replacement project on Barton Street and Baseline Street starting February 18, 2020. This project will be performed in phases and is expected to be completed in April 2020, depending on weather conditions.

On February 18 - 21, District staff will be in your neighborhood surveying the streets to locate existing utility lines. On February 24, construction will begin north on Barton Street and Baseline Street, and progressively continue south on Barton Street. During this replacement, there will be a brief temporary interruption to your water service.

Please see the map on the back of this notice for more information on the homes that will be impacted by this project. Construction is scheduled to take place Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:30 am – 4:00 pm. Street parking will be limited during this project.

In the final phase, the District's contractor, Mike Roquet Construction Inc., will make repairs to the pavement. Notices for no street parking will be placed on your street 24 - 48 hours before paving begins.

Please be cautious while driving through the work zone. For the safety of other motorists and construction crews, please follow all warning signs. We appreciate your patience as we make improvements to the water system. These upgrades represent a significant investment in maintaining a reliable water system for the community served by the District.

IMPORTANT PROJECT DETAILS

APPROXIMATE DATES

Phase 1: Locating Existing Utilities, February 18 - 21, 2020

Phase 2: Water Main Replacement, Fire Hydrant Installation
February 24 - April 2020

Phase 3: Street Pavement Repairs, April 2020

TRAFFIC & PARKING (Phase 2)

Temporary lane closures on Barton Street will be in place to allow for equipment and operational vehicles in the roadway. Residents and emergency vehicles will have access during the project.

WATER SERVICES (Phase 2)

During construction, there will be a temporary disruption to your water services. Customers will receive a door tag notification 24 - 48 hours before the interruption of services.

STREET PARKING (Phase 2 & 3)

Street parking will be limited throughout the project.

STREET PAVEMENT REPAIRS (Phase 3)

This project will include pavement repairs. Notices for no street parking will be placed on your street 24 - 48 hours before paving begins. In this phase, water services will not be impacted.


ABOUT THE PROJECT

WATER MAIN LINE REPLACEMENT ON BARTON STREET

The District has identified a water main line on Barton Street and Baseline Street that needs to be replaced with a larger pipeline. By replacing the undersized water pipeline, the need for maintenance and leak repairs is significantly reduced. Additional project enhancements include the installation of fire hydrants to assist the fire department during an emergency, as well as aid in the maintenance of the water system.

The current Water Master Plan identified the need for a number of capital improvement projects. Selection of these projects have been based on the evaluation of the positive impact that they will each have on customers, maintaining existing facilities, and continuing to meet local, state, and federal requirements.

Shaded residences will be directly impacted by the scheduled project.
